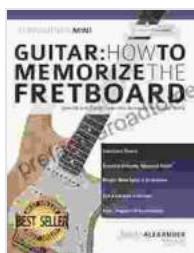

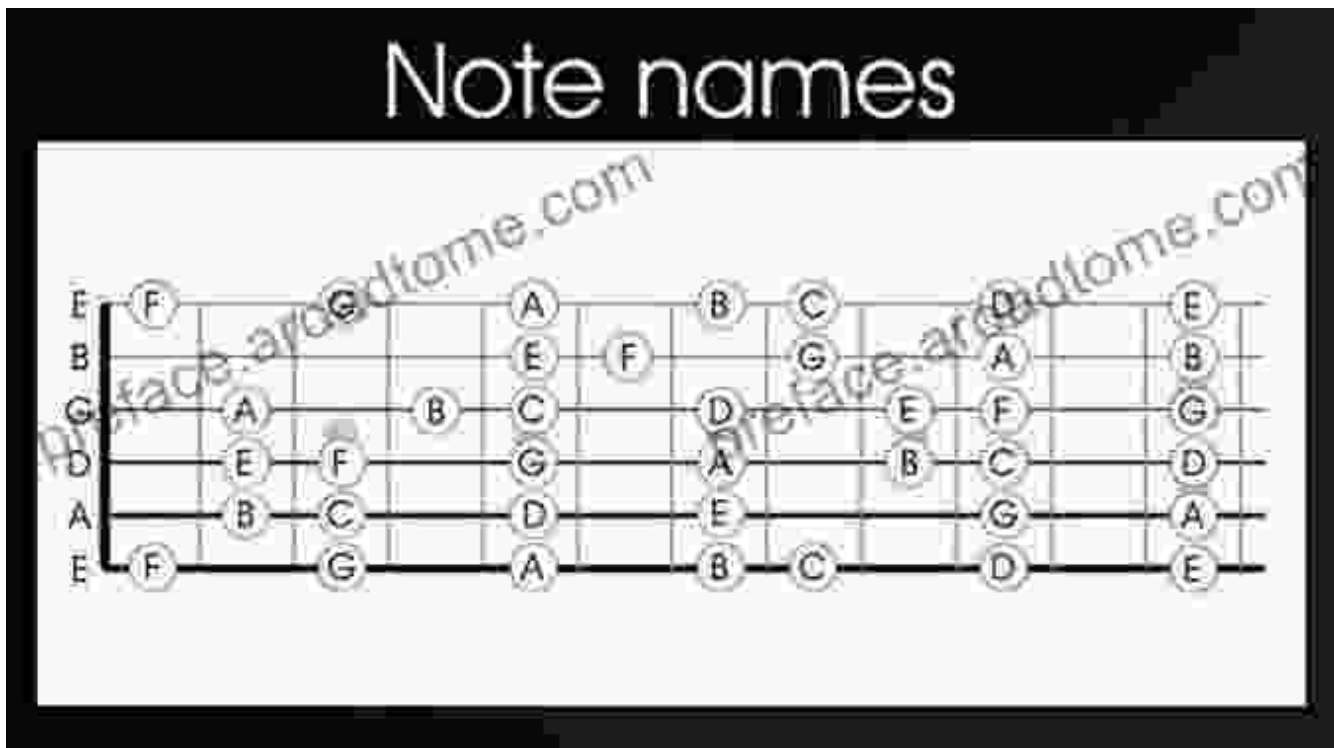


## Understanding the Basics

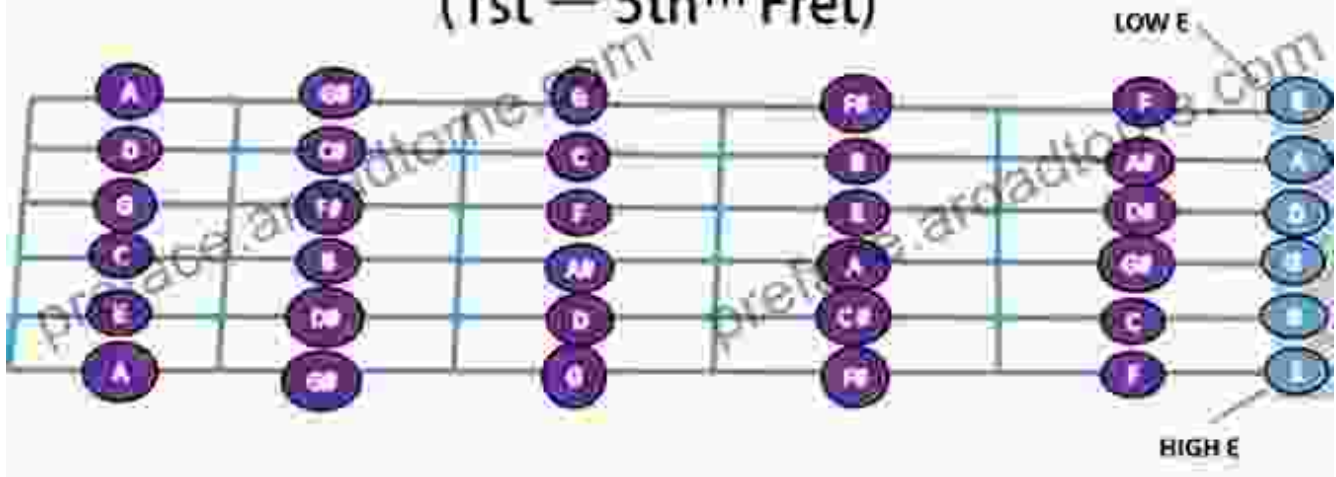
### Learning the Notes

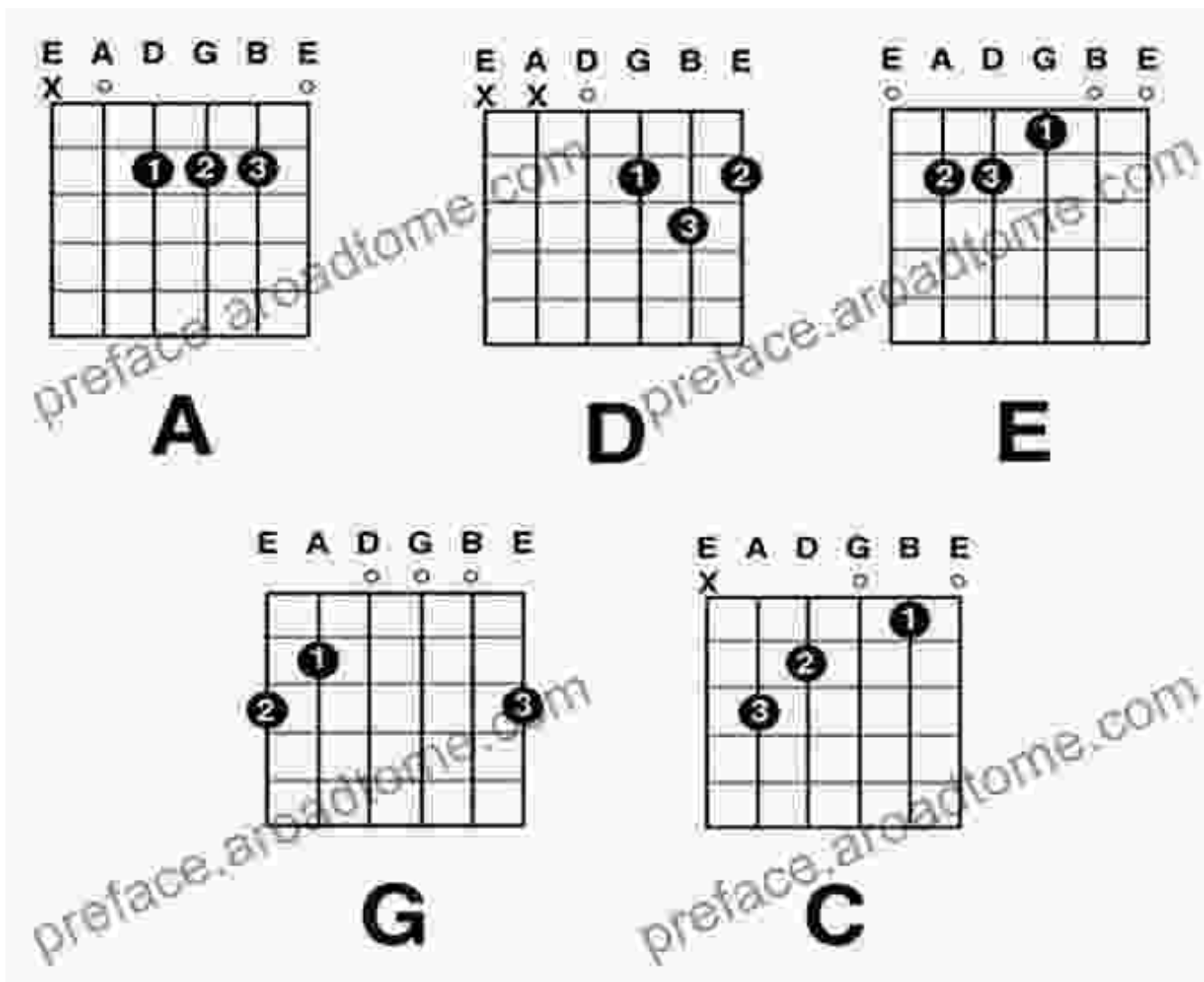
## The Guitar Fretboard Diagram (1st — 5th<sup>TH</sup> Fret)

### **Building Chords**

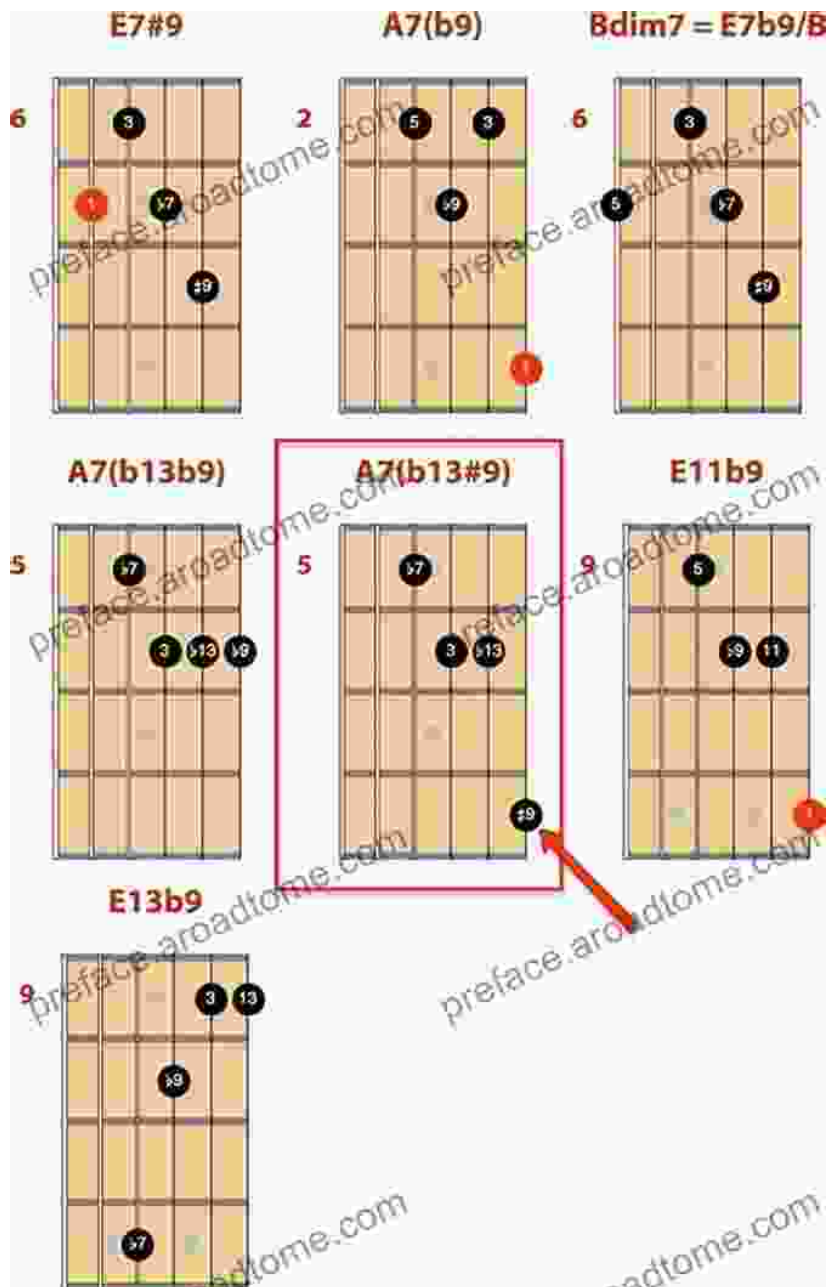

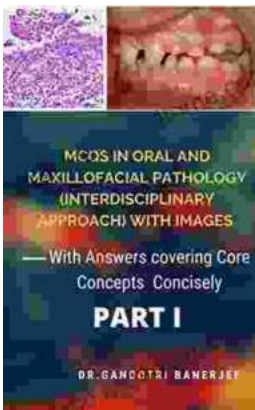

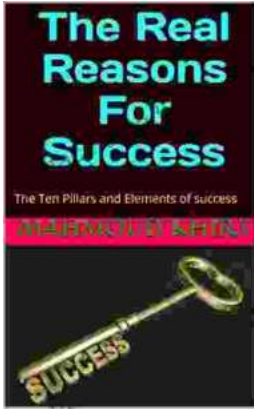
