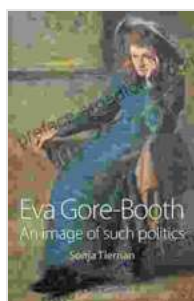


Eva Gore-Booth: An Image Of Such Politics

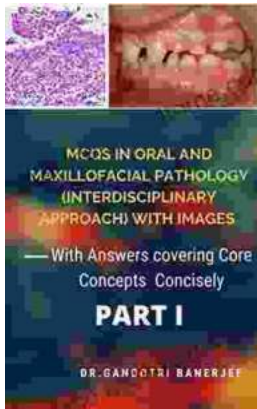

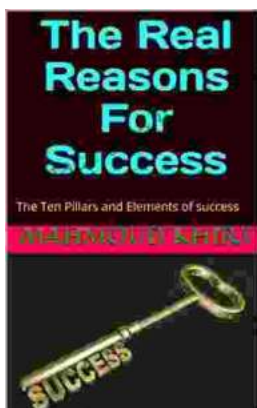
