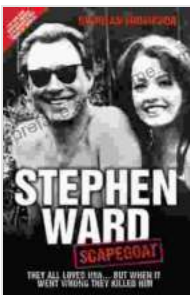


Scapegoat: They All Loved Him, But When It Went Wrong, They Killed Him

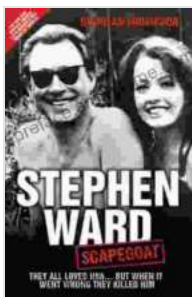

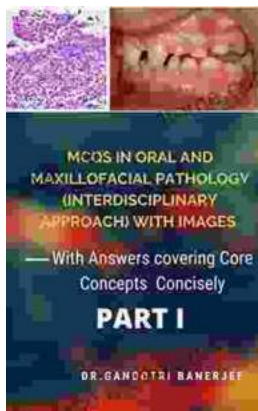

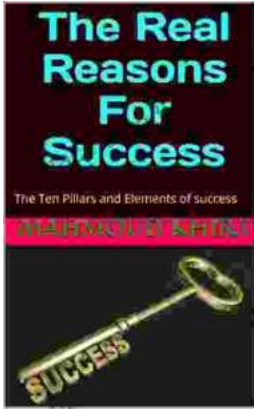
